ELECTION MESSAGE FROM THE CLERK:

The Town of Empire will hold a **GENERAL ELECTION** on **Tuesday, April 5, 2022**. Nominations are open for the position of Mayor and six seats on the Board of Trustees, all serving a two-year term. Candidate Guidelines Packets may be picked up at Town Hall and must be completed and turned in by 5:00 pm on **Monday, January 24, 2022**. To serve, you must be 18 years old, have resided in the Town limits of Empire continually for the last twelve months, and be a registered voter.

Candidate Guidelines Packets include a nomination petition, affidavit to declare your candidacy, candidate instructions, affidavits for campaign contributions, general roles and responsibilities for the position of Mayor and Board of Trustees, and an election calendar. Please call for an appointment to come to Town Hall and pick up your Candidate Guidelines Packet and please bring your ID as you will need to have your signature notarized when picking up the packet.

Since we are a very small community, please be aware that as candidates, you may all be asking the same residents to sign your petition. And as residents, you may be asked by several candidates to sign their petitions. There is a limit to how many petitions a resident can sign, so candidates please do not be offended if someone declines to sign your petition.

Each resident is allowed to sign one petition for Mayor, and six petitions for Board of Trustees, because there are six available seats on the Board. The list of current Board members is always listed at the bottom of every Newsletter, so you know who is currently serving. Please use as much thought and care when signing petitions as you would for casting your vote, and please keep track of how many candidates petitions you have signed.
