We still have two vacant seats on the Board of Trustees for the upcoming two-year term. If you were thinking about running for office but weren't sure what you would be expected to do, we encourage you to come to any town meeting and speak with a staff member, or email the clerk. We'd love to answer your questions. The staff trains all incoming officials, and we hold trainings and work sessions so everyone has the opportunity to ask questions, learn what their role is, and understand how they can contribute. We need more people to volunteer to fill vacant positions. Come to the Board meetings to see your Officials in action, and see if it's something that interests you.

YOU ARE THE FUTURE OF OUR TOWN GOVERNMENT!

You have voted to keep term limits. That means that your current Board members can only be elected for two consecutive terms, then they must step down for four years before running for office again. Many small towns have volunteers that serve two terms, step down for four years, then run again for two terms. Empire encourages our termed-out Officials to run again in the future, however, we still have years in between that need to be filled with new Officials. We need more people willing to run for these vacancies in the future. Could that be YOU? Come to our Board meetings, talk to the Board members, talk to the staff, get to know the people currently serving our community, and find your place to serve. Join Us!
