Town Staff and The Police Department will not be able to help load or unload anything that is going into these dumpsters. Certain items are restricted and will not be allowed: mattresses, paint, oil, fridges, freezers and hazardous materials.

BRING YOUR TREES AND BRANCHES! Clear Creek Fire Authority is bringing a wood chipper to our clean-up day. Please do not bring anything larger than 6 inches in diameter. Also, please bring your branches in a separate load from you trash and large items to throw away.

Dear Town Resident,

The Town of Empire is hosting a Town Clean-Up Day on Saturday, June 22nd, 2024, from 09:00 AM to 1:00 PM (unless the dumpsters are filled before 1 PM). The Town will provide dumpsters for yard waste and oversized items, EXCLUDING household trash, TVs, tires, oil, paint, computers, electronics, refrigerators/freezers, and other hazardous waste. Once the dumpsters are full, we will cease operations, and the dumpsters will be removed.

Participating in the Town Clean-Up Day is not just about improving the visual appeal of our community. It's about taking a stand against varmints, wildlife, insects, and health hazards that can cause issues to you, your neighbors, animals, and the spread of disease. By mitigating these hazards, we not only enhance the aesthetics of our town but also protect property values, business opportunities, and reduce crime.

As part of the Town Clean-Up, we will be stepping up our enforcement of Town Ordinances and State Laws concerning trash and nuisances on property and roadways. Our aim is to educate people about voluntary compliance. Still, please be aware that non-compliance may result in a summons to court and remediation of violations at the property owner's expense. We urge you to take this opportunity to prevent further enforcement.

We are here to help and guide you through the process.
