

Operational Report - Empire Regular Board Meeting  
3-18-25

CCFA:

- We have several old fire hydrants from our replacements last summer, and Chief Babeon has designated which hydrants he wants for training. We will reach out to other Fire Departments to get rid of the remainder.

CDOT:

- Damaged crosswalk sign has been replaced.
- The traffic lights should now cycle instead of staying green all the time. This will create a gap in traffic for the locals to get out on the highway.
- Highway Resurfacing Project
  - Empire Junction interchange on hold because of cost increases.
  - Hwy 40 through Empire is still scheduled to start construction in early May.
  - CDOT may use some office space in Empire during the project, bringing some additional business.

Admin:

- Staffing Report
  - In process - interviews are being scheduled.
- Moving workstations - as we stated in the last meeting, we will be creating individual workstations using our furniture. I hope to have everything rearranged by April 1st. This is being done outside of normal work hours.
- Interviews with Wendy – we are doing directed interviews to document institutional knowledge.

Police Department:

- Bid for surplus vehicle – we received one bid for the old Ford interceptor.
- Officer Hours – We try not to advertise when our officers are on duty because that highlights the days and times they are not on duty. - We are doing some clean-up and rearranging materials in the Ball Placer. There is no development in the Ball Placer at this time, we are simply managing the area so that we can use the materials for projects this summer.
