

RESOLUTION 20-20

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF EMPIRE, COLORADO TO SET FEES, FOR A PERMIT FOR THE USE OF OHV'S WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF EMPIRE AS PERMITTED BY ORDINANCE 231 AS AMENDED

WHEREAS, The Town of Empire, in the County of Clear Creek and State of Colorado, adopted Ordinance 231 – Regulating Off-highway Vehicles in February of 2011;

WHEREAS, in October of 2020, the Town of Empire, in the County of Clear Creek and State of Colorado, amended Ordinance 231- Regulating Off-highway Vehicles to require a permit for use within the Town of Empire; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 231- Regulating Off-Highway Vehicles permits the Empire Board of Trustees to set a fee for off-highway vehicles to cover the cost of administering the permit; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Empire Board of Trustees now desires to implement a fee for off-highway vehicles as set forth in this Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF EMPIRE COLORADO:

Section 1. The above recitals are hereby incorporated by reference

Section 2. Board of Trustees for the Town of Empire desires to set a fee of \$25.00 per permit, per calendar year, for the use of OHV's within the Town of Empire.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.


