## A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF EMPIRE, COLORADO RATIFYING THE EXECUTION OF A LEASE PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH FIRST GOVERNMENT LEASE CO. FOR A 2021 CHEVROLET TAHOE

**WHEREAS,** the Town of Empire (the "Town") has the authority to enter into contracts for any lawful municipal purpose pursuant to C.R.S. § 31-15-101; and

WHEREAS, in 2021, the Town budgeted for acquisition of a police vehicle; and

**WHEREAS**, the collective age of the Town's police vehicle fleet made acquisition of a new vehicle a priority of the Town; and

**WHEREAS**, due to materials shortages created by the COVID-19 public health crisis acquisition of such a vehicle has been difficult; and

**WHEREAS**, when a vehicle became available it was necessary to quickly move towards acquiring it; and

**WHEREAS**, on December 21, 2021, Mayor Wendy Koch and Police Chief John Stein executed a Lease Purchase Agreement with First Government Lease Co. ("Lease Agreement"); and

**WHEREAS**, the timing of acquiring a vehicle necessitated that the Lease Agreement be signed by the Mayor and Police Chief before it could be brought before the Town of Empire Board of Trustees (the "Board"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Board now desires to ratify the actions of the Mayor and Police Chief in executing the Lease Agreement.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF EMPIRE COLORADO:

Section 1. The above recitals are hereby incorporated by reference

<u>Section 2</u>. The Town Board of Trustees hereby ratifies the Mayor and Police Chief's execution of the Lease Agreement.

<u>Section 3</u>. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
