Resolution 22-13

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF EMPIRE, COLORADO ADOPTING THE CLEAR CREEK COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN

WHEREAS, Section 322 of the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. 5165) requires local governments to develop a Hazard Mitigation Plan as a condition for receiving funding for mitigation projects under multiple FEMA pre- and post-disaster mitigation grant programs; and,

WHEREAS, the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) at Title 44, Chapter I, part 201, requires the counties and municipalities to prepare and adopt a local hazard mitigation plan every five years; and,

WHEREAS, The Town of Empire (the “Town”) and Clear Creek County recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within our community; and

WHEREAS, Clear Creek County has developed the Clear Creek County Hazard Mitigation Plan dated March 30, 2022 (the “Plan”); and

WHEREAS, the Plan incorporates the comments, ideas and concerns of the community and of the public in general, ascertained through a series of public meetings, publication of the draft plan, press releases, and other outreach activities; and

WHEREAS, The Plan has been prepared in accordance with FEMA requirements at 44 C.F.R. 201.6I; and

WHEREAS, The Town is a local unit of government that has afforded the citizens an opportunity to comment and provide input in the Plan and the actions in the Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Empire Board of Trustees (the “Board”) desires to approve the Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF EMPIRE, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The above recitals are hereby incorporated by reference.

Section 2. The Empire Board of Trustees hereby adopts the Clear Creek County Hazard Mitigation as this jurisdiction’s Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan and resolves to execute the actions in the Plan.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
