RESOLUTION 22-16**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF EMPIRE, COLORADO MAKING THE 2018
EDITION OF THE INTERNATIONAL FIRE CODE EFFECTIVE WITHIN THE
BORDERS OF THE TOWN OF EMPIRE AS AMENDED**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 32-1-1002 of the Colorado Revised Statutes, fire protection districts are authorized to adopt and enforce fire codes, but such codes shall not apply within any municipality until the governing body of the municipality adopts a resolution stating that such code shall be applicable within the municipality's boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the Board of the Clear Creek Fire Authority, which provides fire protection services both within and outside the boundaries of the Town of Empire, has duly adopted the 2018 Edition of the International Fire Code (the "2018 Edition of the International Fire Code") for use within the District as amended by the changes reflected in **Exhibit A**; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Empire desires to make such codes effective within the Town's boundaries excepting the fire suppression sprinkler requirements for single family and dual family residential units.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF EMPIRE:


Section 1. The Board of Trustees hereby declares the 2018 Edition of the International Fire Code to be applicable within the boundaries of the Town of Empire as amended with the changes reflected in **Exhibit A**.

Section 2. The provisions of this Resolution shall supersede any prior action of the Board of Trustees adopting any other fire code for use within the Town's boundaries.

Section 3. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
