- Comments not topically related to the post for which they are made;
- Profane language or content;
- Personal attacks, harassment and threats of violence;
- Abusive, hateful comments, or those that defame or insult others;
- Comments that stalk, threaten, or violate the legal rights of another or another organization;
- Content that promotes, fosters, or perpetuates discrimination on the basis of race, creed, color, age, religion, gender, marital status, status with regard to public assistance, national origin, physical or mental disability, or sexual orientation;
- Sexually explicit content or language, or links to sexual content;
- Solicitations of commerce;
- Comments or content of a political nature or in support of a candidate;
- Comments that contain false information;
- Conduct or encouragement of illegal activity;
- Information that may tend to compromise the safety or security of the public or public systems;
- Content that violates a legal ownership interest of any other party.
